

# Partners in Island Education Scholarship

## Vinalhaven School

The Experiment invites Vinalhaven School students to apply for the Partners in Island Education Scholarship, which in partnership with The Experiment in International Living, awards \$5,000 annually toward an Experiment summer abroad to one deserving student.

### Scholarship recipients must:

- Be in 9th, 10th, or 11th grade. (High school seniors are also eligible to apply, as long as they haven't matriculated into college/university, yet.)
- Be flexible regarding program placement
- Have financial need
- Be mature, open-minded, and ready to experience a new culture

### Scholarship recipients and their families will need to pay for:

- The remainder of the program fee and international airfare
- Roundtrip domestic airfare to/from the program departure/return airport
- Visa fees, if applicable
- Immunizations, if applicable
- Personal spending money during the program

### Scholarship recipients are required to:

- Write a post-program reflection essay that we will share with our donors
- Write a post-program review on our directory listings
- Attend a re-entry workshop in your area (if offered)

*Applicants not chosen for this scholarship will be considered for The Experiment's other need-based financial aid, providing scholarships of \$250 to \$2,200*

## #1 APPLY

- Before February 20, 2019, complete Experiment's online application for admission and financial aid at [www.experiment.org/pn/apply/apply-now/](http://www.experiment.org/pn/apply/apply-now/)
- On the first page of your online application for admission, choose "yes" to the question "Were you nominated to apply by your sponsoring organization, mentoring organization, or sending high school?" Then, choose "Island Education (Vinalhaven, ME)" from the "EIL Partner Organization/School" drop-down menu.

## #2 GET A PASSPORT

- **US CITIZENS:** Do you have a US passport valid through February 28, 2020? If not, visit <https://travel.state.gov/content/passports/en/passports.html> to apply for or renew your passport ASAP. Do Not Wait!
- **NON-US CITIZENS:** Do you have a passport valid through February 28, 2020? If not, apply for or renew your passport ASAP. Please check with your local embassy about visa requirements and travel restrictions.

- Conditions of Participation Form
- Health Forms
- Electronic color copy of your signed passport

## #4 INTERVIEW

- By March 2019, you will be invited to attend a required group interview session in person or via Skype or phone.
- By April 2019, you will hear from The Experiment if you have been accepted, your program match, and if scholarships/financial aid are applicable.
