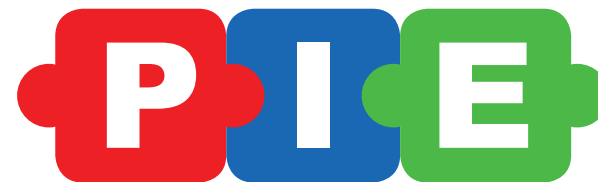

What is PIE's

Vinalhaven College Scholarship

Established in Spring 2006, the *Vinalhaven College Scholarship (VCS)* is a 4-year renewable scholarship of \$3,000 per year, a total of \$12,000, awarded to a graduating senior who will attend a four-year college or university. This scholarship is the most generous Maine scholarship available to Vinalhaven high school graduates. Applicants are considered for their academic achievement, school and community involvement, personal statement of goals, recommendations, and the strength of their connection to the community. This scholarship is not primarily need-based but financial information is reviewed. SAT scores and class rank are not considered. This year we are very pleased to award one *Vinalhaven College Scholarship*.

What is PIE's

Ogden/Chaffey Scholarship

Established in Spring 2010, PIE's *Ogden/Chaffey Scholarship (OCS)* is a one-time award of \$500–\$2,000 for graduating students enrolling in a 1- or 2-year post-secondary or vocational program. Applicants are considered primarily for their work experience, and community and volunteer activities. Academic achievement, school activities, recommendations and personal goals are considered but given less emphasis. If no applicants apply to attend a post-secondary or vocational program, the Scholarship may, at the discretion of the Committee, be awarded to a qualified student attending a 4-year school. This year we are very pleased to award two *Ogden/Chaffey Scholarships*.
