# **PIE** Scholarship Recipients Reflect on Their Experiences

Coming from an island [in] Maine with a year-round population of around 1,200, being in a city was a [new] experience for me. Through hours of exploring with my new friends, I overcame my "fear" and developed the skills I needed to navigate and get us where we needed to go.

My trip to Costa Rica with others from across the U.S. gave me a chance to participate in new activities, meet new people, try to speak a new language, eat new foods, and really immerse myself in the Costa Rican culture.

Living in a third world country made me appreciate the life I have back home. I experienced a whole different life I never really knew existed. I have a better understanding of the world and what's outside of my tiny little island.

I am glad I had the opportunity to participate in Whale Camp. The experience made me more prepared and excited for when I go to college this fall. I was in a learning environment with people I've never met and I got used to being away from home, even if just for a week.

My advice for someone going [away to camp] would be to give it a chance. It will be hard at first, but then it will be fun and worth it.

[At the] Congress of Future Science and Technology Leaders, each speaker had their own way of relaying their personal success story, yet the central message emphasized by all was, "never give up!" My experience at the Congress helped me rethink my future and taught me that the key to success is to work hard, never give up, and do what you love.

I met people with similar interests to mine who were eager to learn. The camp presented new challenges and opportunities to try new things. I also learned important intellectual and social skills that will aid me on Vinalhaven.

Maine Teen Summer Camp was the best thing I have done all year. I had an amazing time and made lots of friends that I still talk to. I learned how to play guitar and learned new songs on my ukulele, which are now my favorite songs to listen to and play. I also went a full two weeks without my phone and didn't miss it one bit. I wasn't homesick either and I got to meet people from all over the world!

Established in 2012 through a generous donation by a summer family, PIE's *Travel & Education Scholarships* are awarded annually to current students who seek to attend travel programs and/or educational programs in the U.S. or abroad. Each *Travel & Education Scholarship* is a one-time award of varying amounts up to \$3,000, and is awarded to multiple students each year. PIE's Scholarship Committee evaluates applicants for the *Travel & Education Scholarship* using a scoring rubric to fairly and consistently evaluate each applicant.

- Quality/appropriateness of program/travel plan
- Student's transcript and academic record
- School and community activities
- Recommendations
- Student's resume
- Financial need

## What is **PIE**'s EIL Partnership Scholarship

Beginning in 2017, one Vinalhaven high school student each year who has already been accepted into *The Experiment in International Living's High School Summer Abroad Program* will be awarded an *EIL Partnership Scholarship* of \$5,000 (\$2,500 of which is contributed by PIE, and \$2,500 by *The Experiment*).

## The Experiment in International Living's High School Summer Abroad Program

This program offers students the opportunity to engage in foreign exchange for 3–5 weeks in Africa, the Americas, Asia, Europe, or the Pacific, while learning the language and traditions of their host country. During their time abroad students gain a deeper understanding of a chosen subject, including the arts, community service, cooking, ecology, language study, photography, and theater, while actively participating in hands-on learning every step of the way. These experiences provide uniquely enriching, once-in-a-lifetime educational opportunities for all participants.

#### **Application Process**

Candidates for the *EIL Partnership Scholarship* begin the process by applying to *The Experiment* in *International Living's High School Summer* Abroad Program. Applications are available at: www.experiment.org.

One Vinalhaven student who has been accepted by *The Experiment's High School Summer Abroad Program* will be awarded the *EIL Partnership Scholarship*, based on consideration of the student's:
